We hope to analyse Kant's aesthetic theory in its historical context and to reveal its contemporary relevance, primarily by showing how his ideas relate to and contribute to issues discussed in contemporary philosophy of art and aesthetics. We invite submission from both Kant scholars working on any aspect of Kant's theory which relates to his third *Critique*, aestheticians and philosophers of art.

Abstracts should be ready for double-blind review, and we kindly ask to remove any identification detail from the abstract and to send the author's name, paper title, and affiliation in the body of the email. Notifications of acceptance will be sent out by June 15<sup>th</sup> 2019.

Presentations will be allotted a total of 40 minutes, ideally 25 minutes of presentation + 15 minutes of discussion.
